

**Williams Lake Community Forest (WLCF) Bursary Application**  
**Bursaries will be Awarded Spring 2024**



**Application Deadline:** Thursday February 15<sup>th</sup> 2023, by 4pm local time.

**Amount:** \$1,000.00

**Term:** student may access the funds after providing proof of enrollment in a full-time accredited post-secondary education program starting Fall 2024 or Winter 2025. Deferral is permitted for up to one year.

**Level of Study:** Formal accredited post-secondary education, for which tuition and expenses will be charged. This includes Trades.

**Fields of Study:** Forestry or Natural Resource Management preferred.

**Region of Study:** Any region offering Post Secondary Training as specified above.

**Academic standing:** Graduated with Dogwood Diploma.

**Eligibility:** Students must come from the WLCF local area, defined as Cariboo Regional District areas D, E & F, or the City of Williams Lake.

**Application requirements:** Submit the form on page 2 and an essay, as explained below.

**Application requirements:**

- Student needs to be from the WLCF local area (a map is available on the WLCF website under Granting Program)
- Student should exhibit natural resource values and goals, and / or be pursuing education related to the Natural Resources or be pursuing the Trades.
- Complete the application form (page 2) and submit a short essay (300-500 words).
- In an attached essay, students must include:
  - who you are,
  - what you have been involved with in your community and
  - what you have been involved with in your school,
  - where and what you are planning to study, if known,
  - **and identify what links you have to the WL Community Forest, to the outdoors in general, or why you are a relevant recipient of this bursary.**
